School Funding Wishlist	
2022 Priorities – Committee agreed to fund this year 1. PSSA Teacher	
Funding extra hours of part time teacher to attend PSSA to ensure we can have a second PSSA team. \$8,000 – agreed earlier this year.	
2. Interactive whiteboard	
\$10-\$14,000 each Electroboard that goes up and down to suit height of different aged children. School will be purchasing two for classrooms and asked the P&C to purchase a third for the library. P&C agreed to match the same style chosen for the classrooms and to support this year. Caroline to provide quote.	
3. Books	
\$5000 library books and \$2,000 class readers – agreed last meeting	

4. Gate intercom

~\$16,000. Quoting in progress, more detail and comparison quote required. Discussed including appropriate electrics to support the installation of electronic sign in the future.

Longer term goals – require additional fundraising and grants to reconsider

- 5. Canteen upgrade ~\$100,000 look out for grants to support
- K-2 toilets neither the school nor P&C can afford this would require department / grant funding ~\$100,000
- 7. COLA sound system ~\$16,000
- 8. Electronic Sign at front of the school ~\$50,000

Books

Further discussion had after last meeting about the \$5000 P&C contribution of library books. The school further presented their case for this amount, and P&C reconfirmed agreement to fund.

Discussion had about negotiating with suppliers to ensure we get the best deal possible.

School Catchment

Stewart has prepared a very comprehensive report to be presented to Jonatan O'Dae.

Lorna and Nicole have agreed to pick up this project and will reach out to get a meeting schedule with Jonathan.

Stewart's presentation has a few missing gaps to be completed first – Stewart to send editable PowerPoint files.

Key point to present – that SIPPS are currently well under our capacity, and would not need demountable to grow.
