**Solar Power Project** - One of the P&C fundraising goals for 2023 is to have SIPPS completely powered by the sun. Thanks to the hard work of our P&C volunteers we were successful in gaining a grant through Ku-ring-gai council for \$2,500 so we could have a full site survey put together.

It was an exciting first step when the survey took place recently. We look forward to this work continuing and the fundraising during the year to have SIPPS completely powered by the sun.

International Women's Day – Thank you to all the volunteers to helped support the school to celebrate International Women's Day on the 8<sup>th</sup> March. Students were provided with a IWD ribbon on the day. 




We ran a selection of social media posts in the run up to the fees statement going home. It was also great that we were able to finalise our 2023 goals in readiness for this.

This money makes such a difference in our small school and really enables us to provide for the school as needed.





**P&C supporting SIPPS PSSA** – Again this year the P&C are supporting SIPPS with competitive sport by helping fund the release time of the staff needed to run the PSSA program. Sport is a big thing at SIPPS and many of our kids are involved in the PSSA competitive sport program. It was great to support the school with \$8,000 for teacher release. Thank you to everyone who has supported the fundraising efforts to make this happen.

**Grants** – We have applied for a number of small grants since our last meeting. This includes one from the Department for help with technology funding and another for helping rejuvenate our garden beds. We are working on a Wellbeing grant at the moment which is scheduled to close in April.

**School Marketing** – The P&C continue to support the school with marketing. This includes Facebook and Instagram. We are still waiting (at time of writing this report) to hear back from the NSW



Department of Education about the promised marketing funding. I hope to hear back soon. IN the interim, we continue to collect photographs and the P&C are supporting the creation of a short video to market the work that is happening in Mathematics and the new role of Assistant Principal supporting the delivery of Numeracy and Literacy.



Swimming Carnival – On behalf of the entire SIPPS community I would like to thank and congratulate the school for such a wonderful SIPPS 2023 Swimming Carnival. A massive shout out to all the parents as well for their continued support. It was great to see all students (whether they were swimming or not) cheering along their classmates.
